

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

CONCERNING THE ISSUANCE BY THE COLORADO EDUCATIONAL AND CULTURAL FACILITIES AUTHORITY OF ITS EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES REVENUE NOTE (FRONT RANGE CHRISTIAN SCHOOL PROJECT), SERIES 2026 IN A PRINCIPAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$7,000,000.

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the **COLORADO EDUCATIONAL AND CULTURAL FACILITIES AUTHORITY**, an independent public body politic and corporate constituting a public instrumentality of the State of Colorado (the “Authority”) will conduct a public hearing on August 7, 2026, at 10:00 am local time, to address the following: (a) the Authority’s proposed issuance of its Educational Facilities Revenue Note (Front Range Christian School Project), Series 2026, in a maximum stated principal amount not to exceed \$7,000,000 (the “Series 2026 Note”), and (b) the plan of finance corresponding to the issuance of the Series 2026 Note.

The Authority intends to loan the proceeds of the Series 2026 Note to Front Range Christian School (the “Company”), a Colorado nonprofit corporation.

The Company is an organization described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the “Code”), and therefore exempt from federal income taxation under Section 501(a) of the Code.

The Company intends to use the proceeds of such loan for the following purposes:

- (1) to refinance the acquisition, construction, renovation, and/or equipping of certain capital improvements at the Company’s campus, operating as an educational facility, located at 6637 and 6657 W. Ottawa Avenue and 6885 W. Marshall Street, Littleton, CO 80128 (referred to herein as the “Facility”); and
- (2) to finance certain costs incurred to issue the Series 2026 Note.

The Series 2026 Note is expected to be a “qualified 501(c)(3) bond” as defined in Section 145 of the Code.

The Company is the owner and principal user of the Facility.

The Series 2026 Note will constitute a special, limited revenue obligation of the Authority, payable by the Authority solely from loan payments made by the Company. None of the faith, credit, or taxing powers of the State of Colorado or the Authority are in any way pledged to the payment of or encumbered by the Series 2026 Note. The Series 2026 Note and the interest thereon shall never constitute the debt or indebtedness of the Authority, the State of Colorado or any political subdivision thereof within the meaning of any provision of the Constitution and laws of the State and shall not constitute nor give rise to a pecuniary liability or a charge against the general credit or taxing powers of the Authority or the State. The Authority has no taxing power.

This notice is intended to comply with the public notice requirements of Code Section 147(f).

Interested persons are invited to attend the public hearing, which will be conducted via toll-free conference call, and present comments (or, prior to the time of the hearing, submit written comments to the Authority at mpalmer@cecfa.org) concerning the Authority’s issuance of the Series 2026 Note and the corresponding plan of finance. To attend the public hearing via conference call dial (866) 704-7500 and enter passcode

612390#. All persons on the conference call will have the opportunity to offer comments regarding the issuance of the Series 2026 Note and the plan of finance.

A report of the hearing will be made to the Treasurer of the State who will consider the issuance of the Series 2026 Note for approval. Approval of the Series 2026 Note by the State through its Treasurer is necessary in order for the interest payable on the Series 2026 Note to qualify for exclusion from the gross income of the owners thereof for federal income tax purposes.
